

TFF Volunteer ~ Dog Mentor Program

Requirements

- ✓ Must be a Regular Volunteer who Signs Up a Minimum of Twice a Week.
- ✓ The Volunteer Must be able to Physically Handle the Dog in Every Aspect: Walking, Lifting and Transporting.
- ✓ Selection is Based upon on Seniority, Physical Compatibility and completely subject to the exclusive approval of TFF Founders.

Responsibilities Include

- Attending Veterinarian Routine Examinations - Spay/Neuter, Medical Procedures. Most Veterinarian Appointments are Scheduled on Monday, Tuesday and Friday.
- Weighing and Charting Medical Care (Capstar, Dewormer, Bathing, Flea/Tick and Heartworm Preventatives, Vaccines, SNAP 4DX, Fecals, Post Spay/Neuter Care) Under the Supervision of Veterinarian Technician, Kristen Seawell/Betsy Ficarro (if applicable). Kristen is on Site Every Wednesday and Periodically on a Saturday.
- Behavioral Training/Assessments (Leash, Basic Manners - Sit & Wait, Housebreaking & Crate Training, Dog, Cat, Children Assessments, Car Loading & Unloading, Car Rides, Public Outings, In Home Assessments if applicable) Under the Supervision of Dog Trainer, Patsy Martin. Patsy is on Site Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday.
- Socialization (Meeting Basic and Additional Needs While in Residence).
- Marketing (Photographs, Flyer Distribution, Dog Handler/Transporter for Events and Fundraisers, Participation in Applicant Review and Meet & Greets, Home Visits and Finalizing Adoptions) Under the Supervision of Betsy Ficarro. Betsy is on Site, Monday, Tuesday, Friday and Saturday. Clerical on Wednesday and Thursday.

- Dogs Tagged for Rescue/DDR (All of the above and more). Profiles, Vet Assessment/ Health Certificate, Other Documentation, Delivering to Transport. Under the Supervision of Betsy Ficarro. Transport Always Leaves on Friday.
