MEDICAL AND BEHAVIORAL ASSESSMENTS, COSTS & ADOPTION FEES

The Farley Foundation takes great pride in caring for its animals on all levels. We are one of the few animal welfare groups that perform comprehensive medical care and behavioral assessments while dogs are in residence. We are committed to each dog that enters our facility to insure that it is placed in the most suitable home so it does not return to the system, where it would be at risk of being unnecessarily “euthanized.”

Adoption fees start at **\$260** subject to increase due to additional medical costs. Once adopted, your new companion is good for approximately one year (except monthly Heartworm and Flea/Tick Prevention) before seeing a veterinarian for its annual exam, routine screenings and vaccinations. The Farley Foundation is able to absorb the majority of medical costs through reduced rescue rates which benefit is generally passed on to the adopter. On average, each dog that is adopted costs The Farley Foundation approximately \$400 not accounting for daily care, behavioral assessment and other labor-intensive support. The longer the dog stays at our facility the more it costs to sustain the superior care we provide.

Annual Vaccinations (Rabies * Bordetella/Kenneling * Distemper/Parvo & Booster)

Spay/Neuter (Post-Op Care) – special circumstances may increase adoption fee

De-Worming (98% of the dogs entering our facility have parasites-numerous treatments)

SNAP 4DX (This tests rules out Heartworm and Tick Borne Diseases) – if treatment is required, then adoption fee will be increased
